

Ignoring White Supremacists Won't Make Them Go Away

Olympia has a long legacy of white supremacy starting with the genocide of indigenous people. In 1856, during the Puget Sound War, the Nisqually Chief Quiemuth tried to surrender to the Governor in Olympia and was Lynched by a mob. Up until the 1960s Black People were required to leave the city limits after dark. In 1992, a young Asian-American man, Robert Buchanan Jr., was beaten to death in Olympia by two Nazi skinheads.

More recently on May 21st, 2015 officer Ryan Donald attempted to kill Andre and Bryson who now are in jail for defending themselves. Neo Nazis were emboldened by Ryan Donald's act and outraged by protests against white supremacy, started organizing more visibly in Olympia. On August 16th, 2016 Daniel B Rowe an avowed Neo Nazi attacked an interracial couple walking out of a bar downtown stabbing one of them 4 times.

Trump's campaign has even further emboldened fascists locally and around the country. In Olympia on march 4th 2017 we saw WSP officers chant "white lives matter" while defending fascist trump supporters then arrest 4 antifascists 3 of whom still have charges pending. This Spring alt right protesters got upset by anti-racist organizing at Evergreen and organized a campaign of doxing people of color, trans people and people they view as "degenerates" and attempting to share their private info online. This also included fascists flyering Evergreen campus with genocidal propaganda in meme form and physically assaulting students. On several occasions now fascists have called in shooting threats to Evergreen putting the campus on lock-down. Alt right group patriot prayer has also targeted Evergreen holding a rally on campus in June. Fascist intimidation and organizing continue daily in Olympia.

It is obvious to those paying attention our problems are not merely local, yet are just one part of a larger upswing in nationalist, white supremacist, misogynist, transphobic, islamophobic, anti-semetic, and other bigted rhetoric and violence.
